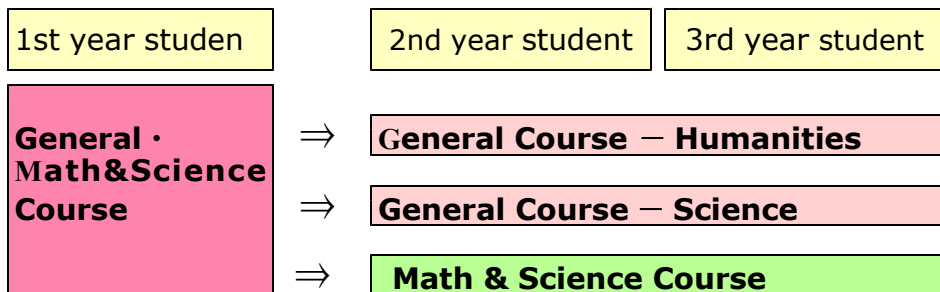


# Curriculum



## General Course

In the General Course, students are subdivided into two courses: humanities and science.
